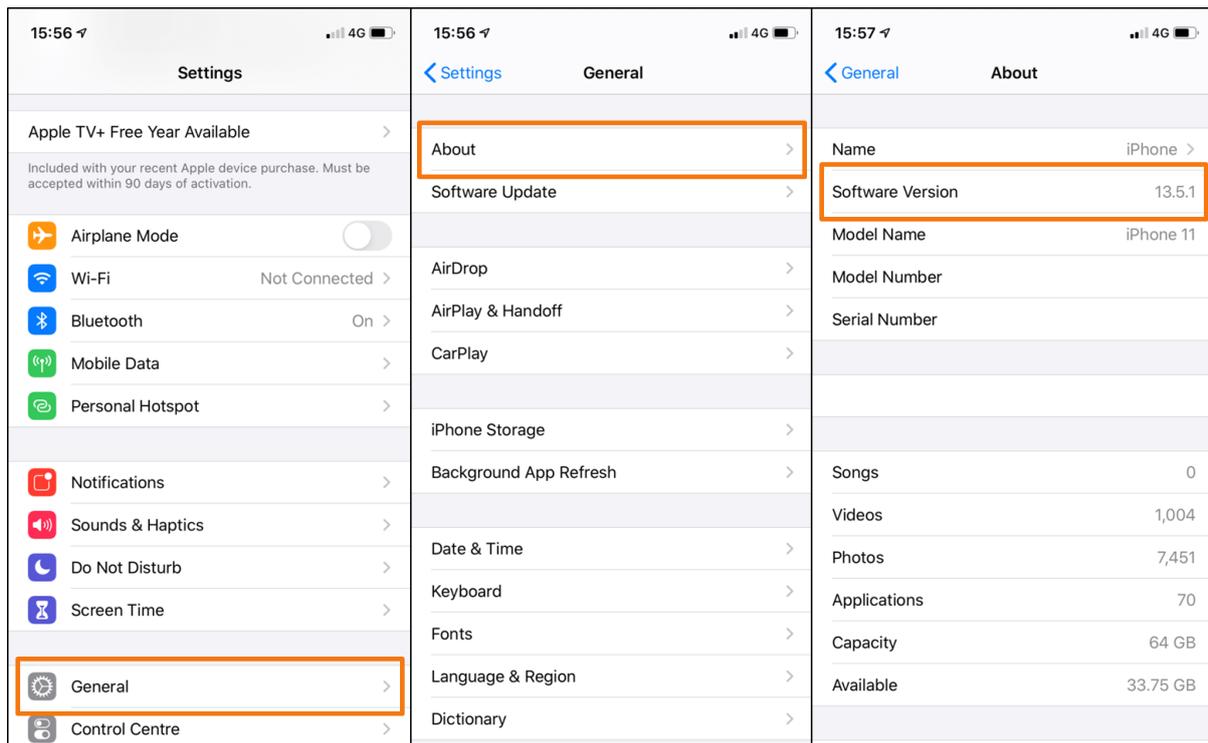


How to find out the software version on your phone

For iPhone users

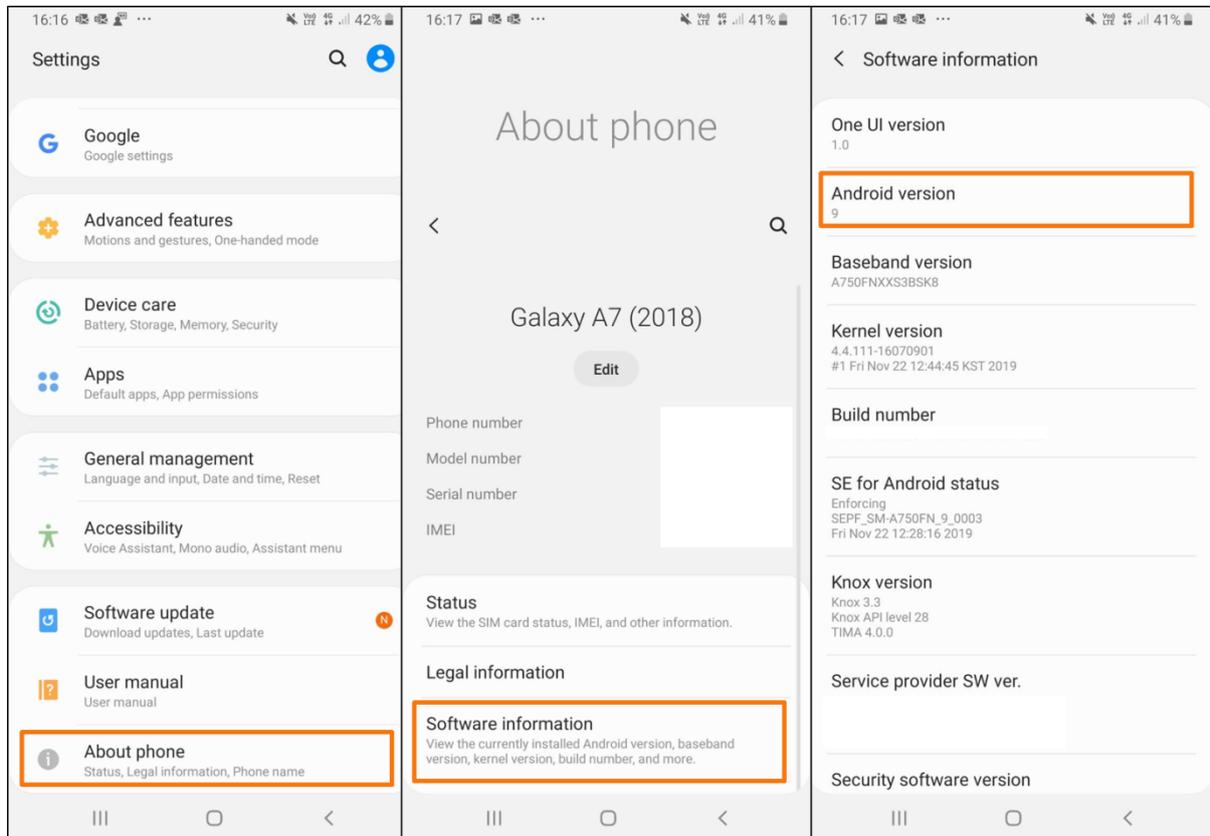
Go to Settings > Scroll down to General > Select About > You will see what version you currently have next to “Software Version”. See image below.

For Android users

Go to Settings > Scroll down to About Phone > Software Information > You will see what version you currently have under “Android version”. See image below.



Huawei: Use the pull-down menu by dragging your finger from the top of the phone. Select Settings and under System, choose About Device. This should list your Android version, Build number and Model Number.

Nokia: Go to Settings > Device > Device Information > More Information
